Realizó un internado en Oncología Médica y Radioterapia en el Angell Animal Medical Center (Boston, 2008) y una residencia en Oncología Médica en la Universidad de Wisconsin-Madison (2009–2012), obteniendo en 2012 el título de Diplomado del American College of Veterinary Internal Medicine (Oncología).

Ha sido profesor en la Universidad Cardenal Herrera-CEU y durante seis años en la Universidad Católica de Valencia San Vicente Mártir. Doctor en Veterinaria por la Universidad Cardenal Herrera-CEU con la tesis 'Nuevas terapias en tumores mamarios caninos y felinos.'

Desde 2015 es cofundador y responsable del Servicio de Oncología de Aúna Especialidades Veterinarias, y desde 2021 codirector de Aúna Especialidades Veterinarias-IVC Evidensia. Ha publicado en revistas científicas, presentado más de 70 comunicaciones en congresos internacionales y participa como ponente en foros nacionales e internacionales. Asimismo, colabora como revisor en revistas indexadas.

Acreditado en Oncología por AVEPA, coordina el Practitioner Certificate in Oncology (Improve International). Ha formado parte de comités científicos internacionales de Zoetis, Boehringer Ingelheim y Qbiotics, y actualmente es Member-at-Large del Comité Ejecutivo de ESVONC y Director de su Comité Científico.

Graduated in Veterinary Medicine from Cardenal Herrera-CEU University (Valencia) in 2003. Completed an Internship in Medical Oncology and Radiotherapy at Angell Animal Medical Center (Boston, 2008) and a Residency in Medical Oncology at the University of Wisconsin-Madison (2009–2012), becoming a Diplomate of the American College of Veterinary Internal Medicine (Oncology) in 2012.

He has taught at Cardenal Herrera-CEU University and for six years at the Catholic University of Valencia San Vicente Mártir. He obtained his PhD in Veterinary Medicine from Cardenal Herrera-CEU with the thesis 'New therapies in canine and feline mammary tumors.'

Since 2015, he has been co-founder and head of the Oncology Service at Aúna Especialidades Veterinarias, and since 2021 Co-director of Aúna Veterinary Specialties-IVC Evidensia. He has published in peer-reviewed journals, presented more than 70 communications at international congresses, and frequently lectures nationally and internationally. He also serves as a reviewer for indexed journals.

Accredited in Oncology by AVEPA, he coordinates the Practitioner Certificate in Oncology (Improve International). He has been a member of international scientific boards for Zoetis, Boehringer Ingelheim, and Qbiotics, and currently serves as Member-at-Large of the ESVONC Executive Committee and Director of its Scientific Committee.
