Además, es Associate Editor del Journal of Veterinary Cardiology, y su labor investigadora se centra principalmente en mejorar el diagnóstico y el tratamiento de la enfermedad valvular en el perro.

Jordi López Álvarez is a European specialist in veterinary cardiology, certified by the European College of Veterinary Internal Medicine – Companion Animals (Cardiology) and accredited by the European Board of Veterinary Specialisation. He is also a diplomate in veterinary cardiology awarded by the Spanish Veterinary Professional Organisation, a Royal College of Veterinary Surgeons Specialist, and holds a PhD from the Royal Veterinary College.
