He is a veterinarian and the Director of Vetoncology, a veterinary oncology service. He is a specialist in oncology, a researcher, and a university lecturer. His main areas of expertise are clinical oncology and electrochemotherapy.

He is a professor at the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine at the University of Buenos Aires. He is a founding member of the electrochemotherapy team for small animals and equine medicine in Argentina, and a member of the Argentine Society of Veterinary Oncology.

He is also a founding member of GiOnCo and is currently pursuing a PhD in clinical oncology and veterinary electrochemotherapy.

He received the IB50K Award for Greatest Social Impact and has received various recognitions and awards for his scientific research in the field.

Matías Tellado is the author of international publications and a speaker at international congresses on electroporation and veterinary oncology. He also serves as coordinator and instructor of the Electrochemotherapy and Electroporation Course at CEMV.
